a year of service

The Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul has created a new ministry in response to the USSCB’s call for a year of service to help mothers in need. After assessing local resources, we have decided to host six pivotal two-hour sessions in early 2021 for direct one-to-one assistance in assessing skills, setting goals and preparing for an education or job placement. We are in the planning stages and looking for volunteers to help in several capacities:

Topic Developers to help research our planned topics and organize each night’s topic.

Speakers who have knowledge/experience in the field of personality/skills, goal setting, career paths and higher education, FAFSA and essay writing, college and job applications, interviewing skills and dressing for success.

Dinner Prep and Servers – we want to serve a light and easy dinner for our participants. The meetings will be held every two weeks for 12 weeks. We will limit the number of participants to 10 women.

Childcare – care for participants’ children and sanitize room.

Leader – this person would coordinate with all others as well as church administration for all meetings, location rooms needed, etc.

Father Mentoring – one-on-one support and mentoring of fathers in need by other fathers
